CODE OF CONDUCT

Welcome to the Oakdale Mall!

We strive to provide an enjoyable and safe environment for all guests and employees at the Oakdale Mall. The Mall, including its designated roadways and parking areas, is private property and no rights shall accrue to the public by virtue of the public's entry into the Mall or on the Mall property. This Code of Conduct is in effect at all times and is subject to modification at any time by Mall Management. Violations of or any person(s) who refuse to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in expulsion from the property, in addition to any other legal remedies Mall Management may choose to exercise including arrest or banning.

In order to provide a safe, secure and pleasant environment, we ask for your cooperation by following this Code of Conduct. Your entry constitutes your consent to abide by this Code of Conduct and all other posted rules.

The following activities are PROHIBITED and are NOT ALLOWED:

1. Use of loud, obscene or offensive language or gestures; sexual or religious slurs; gang symbols or slogans; and displays of pornography or grisly or gruesome materials.
2. Entry without shoes or shirt; clothing expressing an obscene or offensive message; and clothing that does not cover or conceal one's body to prevent indecent exposure or nudity, in each case, as interpreted in the discretion of Mall Management.
3. Loitering, standing or walking in a manner that interferes or is likely to interfere with others or blocking store entrances. Using the Mall as a place of slumber or temporary residence.
4. Running, shouting, wrestling, fighting, horseplay, throwing any type of object, littering, disorderly or disruptive conduct of any nature and engaging in sexual conduct or excessive public displays of affection.
5. Defacing, damaging, vandalizing, destroying or the misuse or abuse of any Mall property or amenities.
6. Being intoxicated, inebriated and or possessing any illegal substance. The use and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances, or the selling or providing alcohol or tobacco products to underage persons.
7. Photography, videography, performances or other entertainment including the playing of musical instruments or audio devices, without prior Mall Management approval.
8. Smoking including electronic cigarettes. **Oakdale Mall is a "Smoke-Free" property.**
9. Use of bicycles, skateboards, roller-skates, roller-blades, scooters, Segways, hover-boards and the like anywhere on the property either inside the Mall or in parking facilities.
10. Picketing, solicitation, leafleting and/or petitioning.
11. All animals except a trained and/or licensed "service animal" accompanying an individual with a disability.
12. Possession of a weapon, even if legally carried, except by law enforcement officers. Explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks over 1/4" diameter; chemical dispensing devices, knives with blades of 2" in length or any other object that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury.
13. Engaging in any act defined by Federal, State or Local law constituting a criminal offense.
14. Overnight parking, parking in non-designated areas, parking in fire lanes or other no parking areas. Parking violators may be subject to ticketing or towing at the vehicle owner's expense.
15. School truancy policies are strictly enforced. Attendance by any minor during school hours when unaccompanied by a parent, teacher or legal guardians is prohibited.
